- 2) When using pre-emergents you can not overseed for about 90 days. Read the label.
- 3) Weather will always determine when you move from one stage to the next and the elements to be used at each round. Drought and high temperatures will effect chemicals and fertilizers. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR READING THE LABEL AND APPLYING THE PRODUCT CORRECTLY.
- 4) Overseed with Rye in fall/winter and Brown Top Millet in spring/summer.
- 6) Lime at 15-20 pounds per 1000 SF or if compacted/acid at 80 to 100 pounds per 1000 SF.
